The HandleBards will tour with Romeo and Juliet and a new children's show, Gnora the Gnome's Daytime Disco, to outdoor venues across the UK from August to September, ensuring audience safety by grouping households together and limiting the capacity of each show.

The HandleBards are a unique theatre company who cycle Shakespeare's plays to outdoor venues across the UK, carrying all of their set props and costumes on the back of their bikes.

As with most touring theatre companies, *The HandleBards* had to cancel their summer season due to the pandemic. During lockdown they put their skills to good use, offering a free groceries delivery service on their bikes for those shielding across South London and free online educational Shakespeare workshops for young people across the world. Alongside these activities they also ran a successful fundraising campaign, securing enough funding to make sure their 2020 summer season will now go ahead in 2021.

With lockdown measures gently easing and three members of the company living in a single household, they've decided to jump straight back to it this summer, repurposing old costumes and props and rehearsing a three-hander version of *Romeo and Juliet* and a new children's show in their living room.

Co-Artistic Directors Paul Moss and Tom Dixon said: "We're excited to get on the road and offer the UK some much needed entertainment. Whilst these shows aren't our usual 4-hander cycle-powered offer, they will be as irreverent, charming and family-friendly as always. We're particularly excited to showcase our first ever children's show for under 10s, *Gnora the Gnome's Daytime Disco*, which we co-produced with *Green Submarine Theatre*. It promises to offer classic disco tunes and gentle fun to help ease your little ones out of lockdown."

"Audience safety and enjoyment are our absolute priorities this summer, which is why we've drawn up careful COVID-19 safety guidelines, limiting audience capacity and clustering households or social bubbles. Sadly this does mean our trademark picnic stealing antics will not take place in this production."

"We're obviously gutted that we will be unable to travel by bike for this short tour, however we are working with the live-event offsetting organisation *Ecolibrium* to balance our unavoidable emissions with investment in clean renewable energy and certified tree planting schemes."
